GUIDELINES BRAKROCK FEST


Brakrock Ecofest takes place in an awesome setting, with lots of amazing bands and people...and we like to keep it that way. Each form of discrimination and violence will be strongly condemned. There's no place for racism, sexism, homophobia, fascism or any other uncool behavior at our festival! But of course you knew that already, didn't you? No pets allowed.

- ▶ No entrance for children > 7 years.
 - ▶ Children up to 12 years old get in for free if wearing ear protection accompanied by an adult.
 - ▶ Full ticket fee for children from 13y – 16y, but they need to be accompanied by an adult. Entering the festival site implies your agreement with all preventive and monitoring measures taken by the organiser or safety team including potential frisking and bag searches. Failing to comply with these measures will lead to refusal or withdrawal of the right of access.
 - ▶ No pets allowed
 - ▶ Don't bring your own drinks. Drinking water wrapped in non – disposable plastic is ok.
 - ▶ Festival tickets cannot be refunded or exchanged for a different event.
 - ▶ The loss or theft of the festival ticket is the liability of the buyer and is not subject to replacement or refund.
 - ▶ Bringing professional photographic, film or recording equipment, alcoholic drinks, glass, plastic bottles, cans, fireworks, weapons or sharp objects onto the festival site is prohibited.
 - ▶ Also, for reasons of safety, you may not bring seating, folding chairs or similar with you. If you do they may be confiscated by security.

- ▶ Starting fires is strictly prohibited.
 - ▶ No hill tumbling.
 - ▶ Entering the festival site implies your agreement with all preventive and monitoring measures taken by the organiser or safety team including potential frisking and bag searches
 - ▶ Failing to comply with these measures will lead to refusal or withdrawal of the right of access.
 - ▶ Do not buy your festival ticket on the street; there is a chance that it is a forgery. Only buy your festival tickets through this site.
 - ▶ The artists and organisers of the festival cannot be held liable for damages, loss or theft or any accident that may occur.
 - ▶ The official sale of t-shirts and souvenirs takes place exclusively on the festival site.
 - ▶ Festival tickets may not be used for commercial or promotional purposes without the permission of the organiser.
 - ▶ In addition, carrying out any commercial or promotional activities on the festival site without the prior permission of the organiser is strictly prohibited.
 - ▶ Festival tickets may not be resold. Festival tickets which have been resold give no right of admission.
 - ▶ The organiser and/or official ticket distributor also reserves the right to cancel festival tickets as soon as it is ascertained that, despite this ban, festival tickets are offered for sale.
 - ▶ The costs arising from cancellation will be charged to the buyer.
 - ▶ Changes to the programme are no reason for a full or partial refund of the festival ticket. The organiser accepts no responsibility in the case of events beyond its control. We will follow Belgian and European regulations/ recommendations in case of a postponed event.

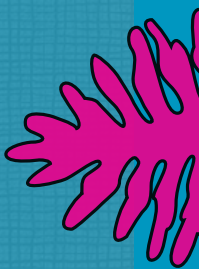

- ▶ Covid 19 update: Organizers can reschedule events to a new date and only have to refund customers if they are unable to attend on that new date," said Nathalie Muylle, Minister of Work, Economy and Consumers on twitter. "This measure should ensure that organizers get through this period and that consumers can continue to enjoy a rich offering in the future".
- ▶ Anyone copying the festival ticket will be prosecuted by law.
- ▶ TV recordings will take place during the festival. There is a possibility that you will be filmed.
- ▶ The organiser and/or official ticket distributor reserves the right to verify the identity of the festivalgoer.
- ▶ The term of refunding a festival goer's ticket after the announcement of the postpone is two weeks.

GUIDELINES CAMP BRAK

- ▶ Dogs are not allowed at the site.
 - ▶ This ticket does not include entrance to the festival.
 - ▶ No refund of tickets.
 - ▶ Bringing glass, plastic bottles (disposable plastic), fireworks, weapons or sharp objects onto the camping site is prohibited.
 - ▶ The organiser and/or official ticket distributor reserves the right to verify the identity of the festivalgoer
 - ▶ Park your car in the free parking area's. There's no need to park your car at the camping.
 - ▶ No BBQ, flyers, camp(bon)fires
 - ▶ Starting fires is strictly prohibited.

GUIDELINES CAMP BRAK

- ▶ There is an alternative, accessible and less crowded entrance for visitors with a disability. One person is allowed to accompany him/her through this entrance.

- ▶ In case of sunshine, please bring **sunscreen** with you. Provide yourself with **good shoes and rain wear** in case of bad weather. There's also rain protection available available at the festival.
